## SPRING MIGRATION DAY HIKE

**The annual Spring Migration Day Hike will be held on Saturday, May 8, 2021 at the Sugar Creek Bluff Natural Area.** This year because of the ongoing concerns due to the pandemic, the number of hikers allowed for this hike will be capped at 36 people. There will be six expert guides with 6 hikers in each of the groups.

Registration will be required. As soon as we receive the information for sign up, we will post it on the Ferryville Facebook page.

To access the trailhead for Sugar Creek Bluff, turn east on North Buck Creek Road just south of Sugar Creek Park on the south edge of Ferryville, drive until you see the signs for Sugar Creek Bluff. There is limited parking so carpooling with your group members is encouraged. We will be meeting at 8 AM. This is a level, easy hike of 1.5 miles round trip.

We will be looking for spring migrating birds especially warblers. This is a Linked to the Land hike sponsored by the Mississippi Valley Conservancy and locally by the Ferryville Tourism Council. We deeply appreciate the sponsorship by the MVC.
