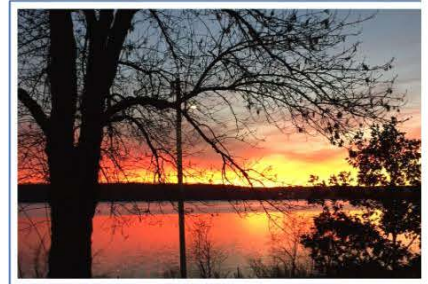

Playground Project - Sugar Creek Park

Fundraising continues for the addition of playground equipment at Sugar Creek Park. As of 7/1/18, \$25,000 has been raised (Goal is \$55,000 - \$70,000) to not only acquire the new playground section but to also do a more flood resilient base which is concrete covered by a “poured in place” commercial surface. The major summer fund drive by Ferryville Vision & Promotion (FV&PB) is the River Bluff Daze Raffle.
