## SUGAR CREEK PARK PLAYGROUND UPDATE



Fundraising continues for the addition of playground equipment at Sugar Creek Park. As of 10/1/18, \$27,000 has been raised (Goal is \$55,000 - \$70,000) to not only acquire the new playground section but to also do a more flood resilient base which is concrete covered by a “poured in play” commercial surface.

Fundraising continues with Soup and Salad Suppers scheduled for 5pm – 7 pm on Thursday, Oct. 11, Nov. 15, January 10, March 14 and April 11. Shullsburg Creamery – Cheese products will be available for purchase at the Suppers which are now part of the fundraising thanks to the Marc Bulandr family. All proceeds go to the Playground Fund. New Grant applications have been submitted to Crawford County Community Fund, AARP, Viroqua Food Coop Foundation and others.

A new swing set was purchased with Crawford County Community Fund Grant funds and donations from the Playground Fund. This replaces the small swing unit that is very old and needs to be retired. The new unit has 2 sling swings and a baby swing.
