FALL MIGRATION DAY

The seventh annual Fall Migration Day will be on Saturday, Nov. 9, from 9-11 AM at River View Park.

Expert birders, Brenda Kelly, Mississippi River Wildlife Biologist with the Wisconsin DNR and Dennis Kirschbaum, retired ranger from Effigy Mounds and active member of the Prairie du Chien birding community, will be on hand with their spotting scopes as we look for the migratory water fowl who use the Mississippi Flyway to navigate their way south. Treats and handouts will be available. This is an event celebrating Ferryville's status as the smallest Bird City, in the over one hundred communities in Wisconsin, who value and share information and education about birds as part of the statewide Bird City program.

New Grant applications are being sought and the Paint for Play Party will be rescheduled with a date to be announced very soon.
